

## Prof. Dr. Arh. Ana Maria Zahariade

Prof. dr. **Ana Maria Zahariade** is architect and teaches theory of architecture at the University of Architecture and Urbanism «Ion Mincu» in Bucharest. After 1989 she has been involved in the modernisation of architectural education, in the architectural research and its connections to larger cultural milieux; Herder prize (2013); Getty and Getty-NEC scholarships; fellow of the Nantes Institute of Advances Studies (2011–12).

Research directions: Romanian modernism, communist and post-communist architecture, housing, and aesthetic concepts in theory of architecture. She is founder (2013) and director of the annual journal *sITA (Studies of History and Theory of Architecture, Ion Mincu University Publishing House)*. She published in Romania and abroad as author, coauthor, collaborator and coordinator. Last titles: *Symptoms of transition 1 and 2* (Arhitext Design, 2009, 2010), *Architecture in the communist project, Romania 1944-1989* (Simetria, 2011). Since 2014 she is vicepresident of the Romanian Chamber of Architects.
